What Is the Pirate Box?

- TL;DR, a SBC, router, or other device that shares files over a LAN/WLAN (mesh networking is also part of this)
- An educational device to teach the public about online censorship, surveillance, and freedom of speech
- PRIVACY!! No logs or access information collected from users!
- More education! Teaching users and devs about networking and system design!
- Optionally, a communications network as well! Message boards, chat rooms, a forum... it can be done!
- Despite the name, it's not just about piracy!

Okay, how do I build one?

- Basic components are easy enough
- Key parts: SBC, OS, portable router, portable storage (and this is where the fun lies!)
- Original Pirate Box project allows for installation to routers or Raspberry Pi
- Revival project is aiming for more flexibility with SBCs and software setup
- Don't worry; we'll get to all that!

The Software Side of Things

- Bare basics: a Linux distro (Raspberry Pi OS, Debian, Ubuntu, Arch, etc.)
- Media server: Jellyfin, Enby, etc.
- Books server: Calibre
- Chat server: Rocketchat, etc.
- Landing page: Hugo
- (This is just a basic layout. The idea is flexibility!)

Reviving the Project and Why

- Fascism is on the rise; censorship is a very real danger
- Helping marginalized communities and people (POC, LGBTQIA+, lower class families, etc.)
- Easy way to get banned books and movies to communities that can benefit from them
- Spreading of education and ideas
- Makes for a cool way to share media with a large group of people
- Brings everyone together!
